

## **GUNDOLF BEIER FOUNDATION AWARD**

The Gundolf Beier Foundation Award is made to a presenting first author and acknowledges innovative research in the areas of accident statistics, accidentology, real-life crash testing, occupant safety and active vehicle safety. The award marks work which is likely to have a lasting impact and thus represents a significant advancement for traffic safety. Papers will be judged on the basis of advancement of knowledge, the quality of the research, and of the written and oral presentations. If there are no suitable papers, the award will not be made.

This personal award consists of a certificate of recognition as well as complimentary registration for the first author at the following year's IRCOBI conference.

The award will be made during the conference.

### **Qualifications**

1. The paper should be submitted under the normal review procedure.
2. The candidate must be first author.
3. The candidate must present the paper at the IRCOBI conference.

### **Application**

There is no application necessary. All full papers presented at the conference are automatically considered for the award if they fall within the defined scope.
