

## **TOYOTA Travel Grants**

Sponsored by TOYOTA, we offer a grant programme to encourage attendance at and participation in our annual scientific conference by professionals who are beginning their career path and advanced degree candidates (Ph.D., M.D.). Candidates must be engaged in research in injury biomechanics, accident investigation, analyses of injury databases, human body modeling, sports or blast injury, epidemiology, integrated safety or in another field with direct implications for injury biomechanics.

Individuals who meet the criteria, as decided by the IRCOBI Council, will receive a grant of up to 750 EUR and complimentary registration for the full conference.

The award will be announced well before the conference (usually early July).

## **Qualifications**

1. The candidate must be a young professional or an advanced degree candidate in a field as outlined above.
2. The candidate must attend IRCOBI conference.

## **Application**

Candidates are requested to submit the following information:

- full name and academic degrees,
- postal and email addresses
- if employed, current full-time or part-time position and place of employment with accompanying employer's documentation letter
  
- if a student, the name of university or institute and academic supervisor's written confirmation as to student's status
- length of time involved in biomechanics research and areas of specialization,
- 500-word summary of past studies/projects (if research was published in a peer-reviewed journal or as an official government/university report, give citation)
- description of current research underway.
