

IRCOBI Travel Grants

The IRCOBI is delighted to offer travel grants to qualified delegates attending our conference. Each grant consists of a cash award of 500 EUR to defray travel costs plus complimentary conference registration.

Qualifications

Candidates must be:

- a) A Bachelors or Masters student majoring in a field applicable to IRCOBI's goals and objectives, or
- b) A Masters or Doctoral student performing research in a field applicable to IRCOBI's goals and objectives, or
- c) A graduate who completed their degree after the prior year's conference and who will be presenting their research work at the conference.

Other Criteria

Since the travel grants are often over-subscribed, priority will be given to students presenting full papers, followed by students presenting short communications, followed by applicants who are not presenting.

Students are eligible to receive a travel grant only once if they do not present a full paper or short communication. Students are eligible to receive a travel grant twice if they present a full paper or short communication at least once.

A maximum of two students per supervisor are eligible for travel grants in a single year.

Application Process

Fill out the Travel Grant Application Form (URL link). The application is limited to one page (A4 format) and must be submitted in PDF format. A legible font size is required.

Email the completed form to the IRCOBI Secretariat: secretariat@ircobi.org.

After reviewing all applications, the IRCOBI Grants and Awards Committee will award as many grants as possible based on the budget available.

Deadline for applications is 11:59 pm CET on June 1, 2024.

Late applications will not be considered.

Awards will be announced by July 1, 2024.
