

IRCOBI abstracts

Abstracts are required for full conference papers (not short communications) and must be submitted via our online submission portal: <https://conference.ircobi.org/>

A login is required. In case you have already submitted to IRCOBI previously, your login is still valid. If necessary, you can request a new password following the corresponding link on the submission page. If you are submitting an abstract or manuscript for the first time, please follow the instructions on the website to apply for a login; this application process can take up to two days as logins need being approved.

Please prepare your abstract as outlined below. Then copy the text in the corresponding boxes in the online system. Note that once you have submitted the abstract it can no longer be changed !

The following information is required for abstract submission:

a) ABSTRACT TITLE

b) STRUCTURED ABSTRACT

- Your abstract must address the following sections:
 - research question / objective
 - methodology
 - results
 - conclusions
 - novelty of the studyAll sections must be addressed, i.e. our online submission tool will only allow you to proceed when there is text provided for all sections.
- Pictures, diagrams, equations or tables must not be used in the abstract.
- The abstract must not exceed a total of 500 words.
- During the submission process you are asked to assign one of the following topics to your abstract:
 - accident analysis / injury epidemiology
 - blast injury
 - brain / head injuries/ helmets
 - computer modelling / human body models
 - dummy technology
 - integrated safety / driver behaviour
 - lower extremity injury
 - other
 - spinal injury
 - sports injury
 - thorax injury
 - tissue biomechanics / tissue characterization
 - vehicle technology / restraint systems
 - vulnerable road users
