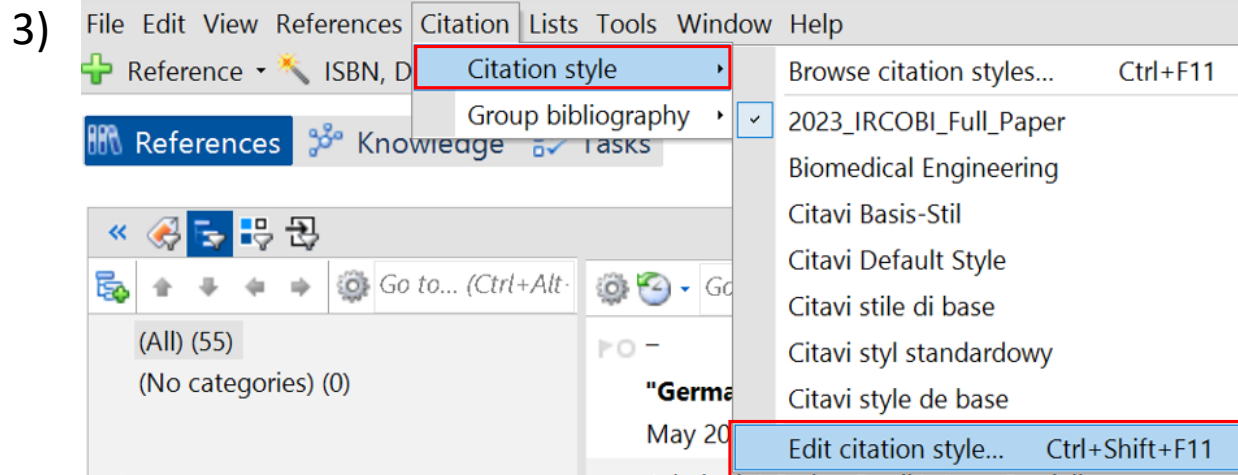


Style guide for „2023_IRCOBI_Full_Paper.ccs” using Citavi 6.17 with MS Word 2019

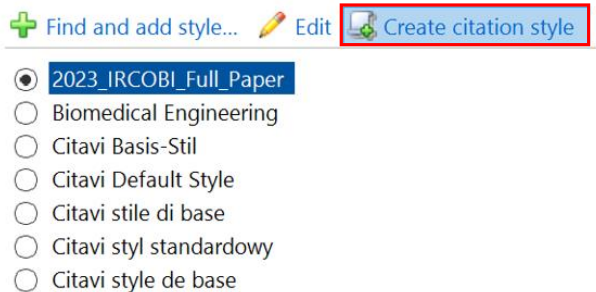
In Citavi 6.17...

- 1) Download and install Citavi 6.17 (including the MS Word Addon): <https://www.citavi.com/en/download>
- 2) Save the citation style file (.ccs) in the Citavi user folder: e.g. 'C:\Users\<NAME>\Documents\Citavi 6\Custom Citation Styles\'

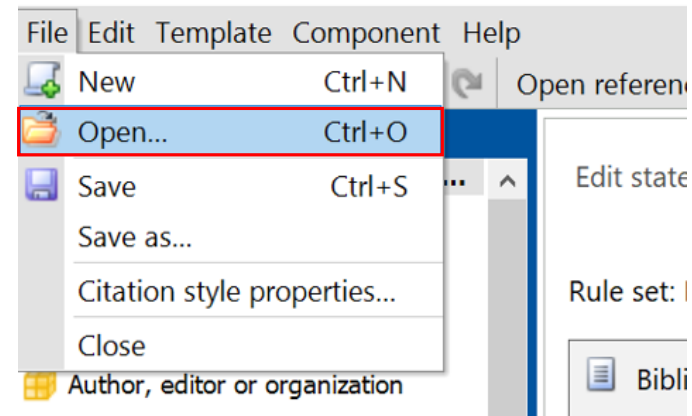


- 4) Local project - Citavi

- 5) New citation style - Citavi Citation Style Editor



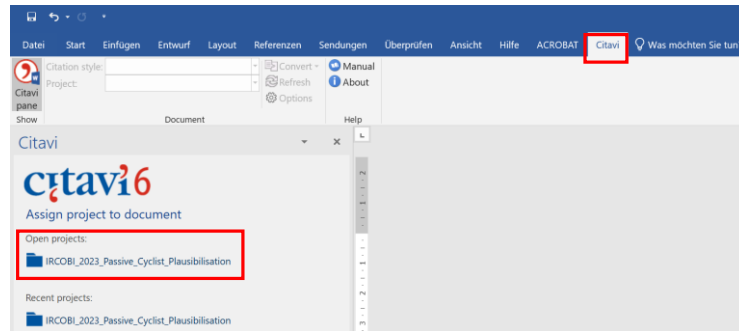
Open the citavi citation style file

- 6) Select the new citation style from the dropdown menu as shown in „1)“
- 7) Create a project and add references

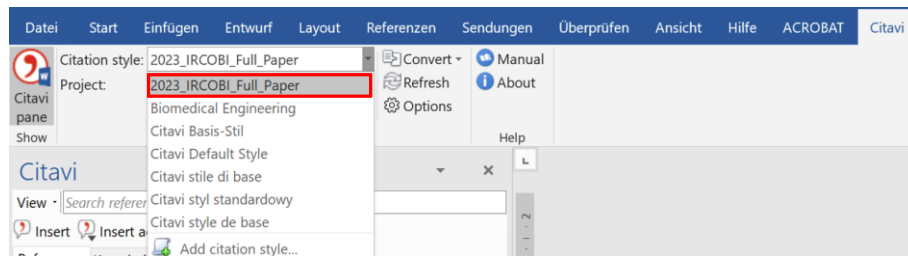
In MS Word...

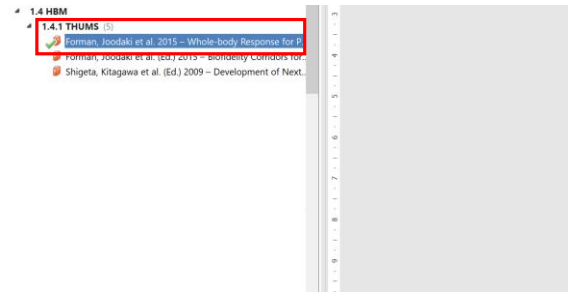
Select the „Citavi” tab and open the project previously created and saved in Citavi
